Erin Merryn is an author, activist, speaker, wife, mother and force behind "Erin's Law." Author of "Stolen Innocence", "Living for Today", and "An Unimaginable Act." She was named Glamour Magazine 2012 Woman of the Year, People Magazine "a HERO among us", and one of the fifteen women changing the world in 2014.

After suffering years of sexual abuse Erin broke her silence when she was 13. She has reclaimed her voice and began her journey to healing.

In 2008 she began writing legislators to require personal body safety be taught to kids in school. This decision has brought her on a crusade across America to pass what is knows as "ERIN'S LAW". This is the first US child sexual abuse prevention education law. It requires schools to provide this education to all children. She has been traveling state to state for 7 years and it has now passed in 31 states as of July 2017.
